## Release Notes

Metrix 3.0 is a major new release with a significant number of new features. For a list of the main new features please see the What's New in Metrix 3.0 document.

## Installation Notes

Metrix 3.0 can be installed on Windows or Mac OS X (Intel only) using an installer for each platform. Metrix 3.0 must be installed as a new full installation.

### Windows XP

Download and run the installer, the file called *install\_Metrix\_3\_0\_b525\_Windows.exe*, from the web page:

### Mac OS X 10.4 or 10.5

Download the zip file called *install\_Metrix\_3\_0\_b525\_Intel\_Mac\_OS\_X.zip*, from the web page:

From this zip file extract and run the installer, a file called *install\_Metrix\_3\_0\_b525\_Intel\_Mac\_OS\_X.app*.

### Database

If you wish to use existing databases from any version of Metrix 2.x (or a Metrix 3.0 Beta), copy the database files (the files in the 'data' subfolder of your existing Metrix installation folder) into the 'data' subfolder of the new Metrix 3.0 installation folder.

When Metrix 3.0 is first run, if there are no existing database files in the 'data' folder Metrix will automatically create a new version 3.0 database. If database files are found but they are for an older version, Metrix will offer to automatically upgrade them if necessary. As usual, this database migration is not reversible so be sure to back up the database files first.

### Passwords

Metrix 3.0 requires a new password and is a chargeable upgrade for customers without a current Annual Service Agreement. Existing Metrix 2.x and 1.x dongles can be used with the new version (with a valid version 3.0 password of course), and the same dongle and password combination can be used for either the Windows or Mac OS X platform.

## Known Issues

1. When installing on Mac OS X if the user selects to create aliases in the dock these are not actually created.
